- 8. The training provider must have valid CTEVT affiliation to conduct the proposed training on related occupation.
- 9. The Trainings are expected to commence from March 2019.
- 10. The training provider with its consortium industries should submit duly filled EOI format according to the issued Terms of Reference (TOR) through e-bidding process.
